Today, a wide variety of recent and sustained trends are driving the importance of a career readiness offering.

ECONOMIC

- ✓ Higher youth unemployment, including decline of jobs fit for those with only HS degree
- ✓ Growth of “middle jobs” (requires training above HS diploma but below Bachelor’s degree)
- ✓ Skills gap between High School preparedness and needs of today’s 21st century labor market

POLICY

- ✓ Increasing state support, along with sustained federal government support
- ✓ Proliferation of CTE advocacy initiatives
- ✓ Some employers willing to invest in future workforce (i.e. funding, internships, etc.)

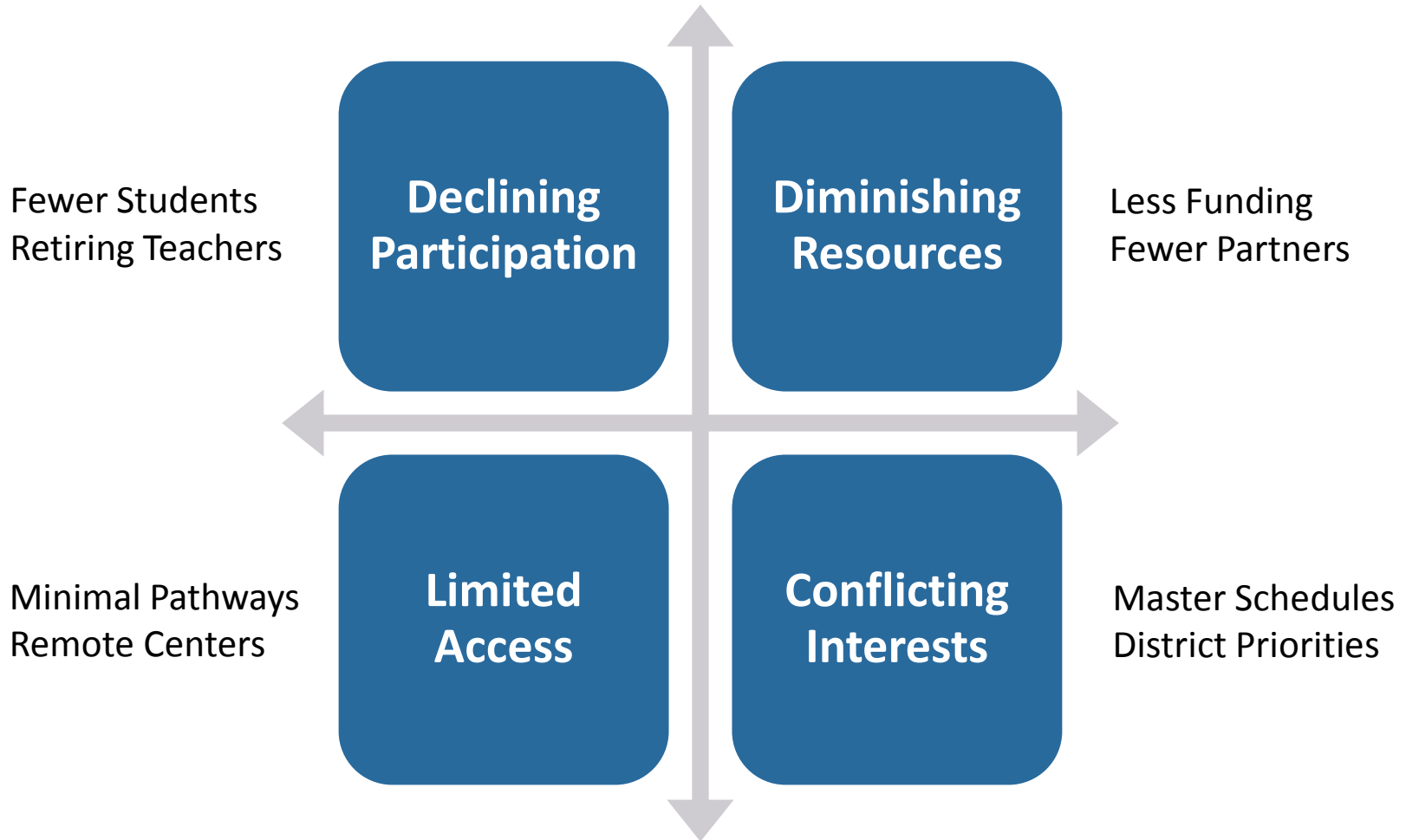
EDUCATION

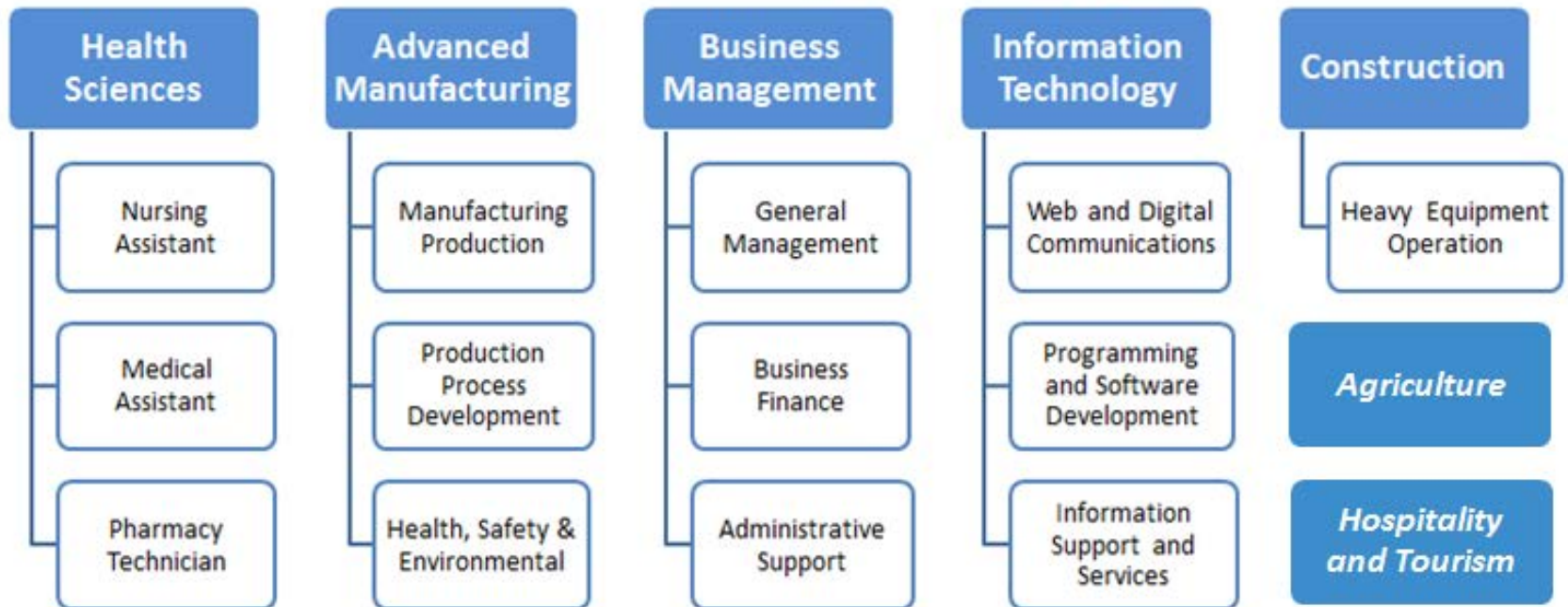

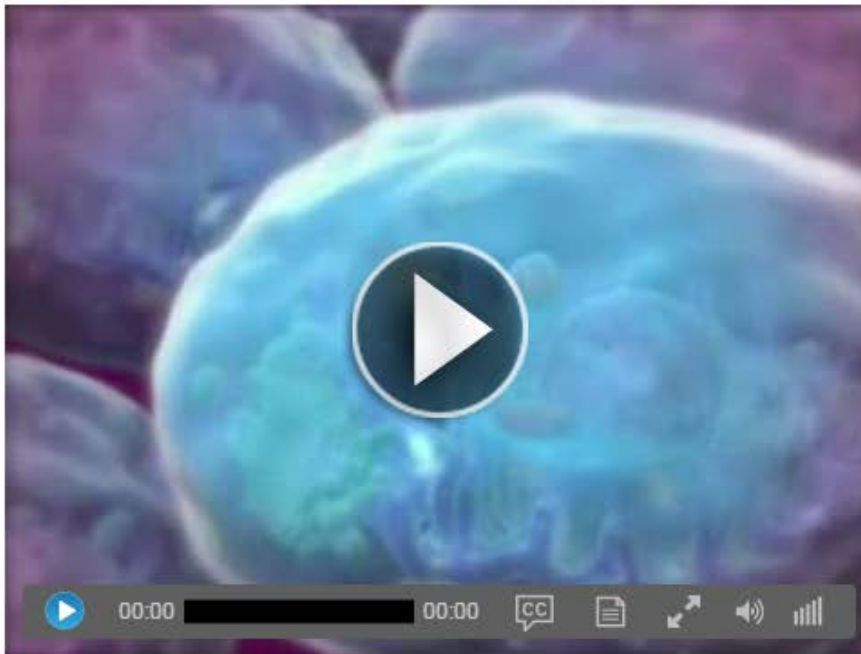

 - College & career planning tools
 - Internships
 - NCRC Test Prep
 - Counselors & other support service
- Program cost and services would be based on course volume
