# **Missouri School Directory 2016-2017:**

As was indicated in the annual membership renewal, MARE is making a copy of the Missouri School Directory (last one published 2010-2011) available to each <u>member</u> school district and associate member. ## "RYH4K"

The MARE Executive Board is one of several organizations in Missouri that are opposed to the passage of the initiative – "Raise Your Hands for Kids." The MARE organization very much supports the need for Early Childhood Education but has some serious concerns about some of the language found within this ballot issue and the effect its passage would have on rural school districts in Missouri.

Amendment 3 is a Smoke Screen that uses Kids to Sell Cigarettes. The Missouri Ethics Commission records show that an affiliate of RJ Reynolds Tobacco Company has provided over \$3.5 Million in funding for three front groups pushing a tax increase that uses kids as pawns to sell more cigarettes. And, a recent newspaper article quotes Reynolds spokesman saying that they will spend \$5 Million more for the campaign. Front groups include:]

- Raise Your Hands 4-Kids -- \$2,776,361.49
- Early Childhood Education Initiative -- \$471,500.00
- Yes on Amendment 3 for Kids -- \$2,090,654.15

In a press release on Monday, September 19, a large bipartisan coalition of state representatives (91) and senators (19) from across Missouri are encouraging voters to vote "NO" on this controversial constitutional amendment that contacts several troubling provisions. To see the position of your representative or senator, the press release may be found on the MARE website. In addition, both candidates for Governor have come out in opposition to this Amendment.
