**Legislative Issues of Concern** - Superintendents, principals, teachers, Board members and others who support public education are encouraged to get informed and stay active in reaching out to your Representatives and Senators during this legislative session. Bills of concern at this point include the following:

SB 160 - This is a Voucher Tax Credit bill sponsored by Senator Koenig.
SB 292 - This is a Charter School Expansion bill sponsored by Senator Eigel.
SB 73 - This is a Mandatory Reading Intervention bill sponsored by Senator O'Laughlin.
HB 581 - This is a Charter School Expansion bill sponsored by Representative Roeber.
HB 161 - This bill, sponsored by Representative Knight, seeks to direct or limit when schools can start in the fall.

HB 401 - This bill, sponsored by Representative Bayse, seeks to direct or limit when schools can start in the fall.
