Screening for Dyslexia and Other Disorders Course

I'm the program coordinator for eMINTS eLearning at the University of Missouri College of Education.

I wanted to let you know about **Screening for Dyslexia and Other Related Disorders**, a new allonline self-paced course we've developed to address the new state mandate for teacher dyslexia training. The course is 2 hours long, as required by the state, and was developed by **Erica Lembke**, **Ph.D.** a professor and chair of the Department of Special Education at the University of Missouri.

A big reason we developed this course is for rural districts like the ones in your organization, where traveling for professional development is often costly.

The course is \$40 per participant, but we offer discounts for multi-seat purchases starting at 10 seats and above.
