The legislative session is upon us and many bills touted as Education Reform are being heard in committees and will likely soon be debated on the House or Senate floor. Please note the following bills and ask your elected Representatives and Senators to vote <u>NO</u> on - HB 942 (School Accreditation & Assessments), HB 349 (Voucher Tax Credits), HB 137 (Charter Funding), SB 55 (Education Omnibus Bill), HB 151 (Superintendent Consolidation), HB 754 (Virtual Expansion), HB 303 (Open Enrollment), HB 543 (Open Enrollment). We have to stand together to defeat these bills!
