Report It, Don't Repost It

Students, as a reminder, threats are never a joke, they are not funny. If you see something that you feel <u>could be a threat</u> or something that <u>could</u> put anyone in danger, report it to an adult immediately. An adult could be a parent, teacher, school administrator, and/or local law enforcement.

You should never re-share or forward the post to other students for the sake of gossip, even through text messages, or social media- or you may become involved in the investigation. Report it, don't repost it! Report threats to trusted adults such as parents, school administrators, and local law enforcement. You can also contact the Missouri Highway Patrol through the "Courage 2 Report" helpline. Text CR2 to 738477.

Any student found making threats or being involved in passing along gossip of possible threats creating false alarms rather than reporting could face strong disciplinary action in accordance with the student handbook and board policy due to the material substantial disruptions in the school environment caused by such activity. Such activities create substantial disruptions in the school environment.

Those students who are guilty of making threats, disruptive alleged threats that may be deemed as "not credible", or false alarms, could result in a 180-day suspension or possibly permanent expulsion from public school.

Not only could students face disciplinary action at school, but they could face legal consequences with both juvenile and law enforcement. One poor choice could negatively impact a student for a lifetime. And all these types of choices make school feel less safe for students and staff. Think before you post or speak.
