High School Seniors Scholarship Opportunity:

MARE is pleased to announce that the organization will be accepting applications for up to ten (10) \$500.00 scholarships that will be awarded to Seniors in MARE member districts who have expressed interest in pursuing a degree in education. Guidelines for the Rural Missouri Scholarship Fund.

The level of economic development of an area is directly related to the quality of education available. To improve economic development in rural Missouri, an adequate number of well trained, dedicated teachers must be available to instruct in rural school districts. MARE is making available 10 -- \$1,000 scholarships.

Application and guidelines are now available on the MARE website (<u>www.moare.com</u>). All Missouri colleges/universities offering teacher education programs have been notified of this scholarship opportunity.

Components of the Scholarship Selection Criteria:

- Only junior and senior level Missouri college/university students qualify as scholarship recipients. (Exception – Colleges/Universities that do not approve students' major in education until they are enrolled in a 5th year program.)
- Eligible students are those who have successfully completed 60 credit hours and have declared a major in education.
- A scholarship recipient may reapply in a subsequent year for another scholarship.
- Applicants must have achieved a 2.5 grade point on a 4.0 scale.

Application Deadline: March 24, 2017

The annual National Rural Education Association Foundation Essay Contest allows contestants to

participate in three divisions: elementary, middle/junior high and high school. Grades 3-8 may participate in a written essay contest using the provided prompt and rubric. Grades 9-12 may participate in a video essay contest using the provided prompt and rubric. The winner of the elementary division (3-5) receives \$250. The runnerup will receive \$100. The winners in the middle/junior high and high school divisions receive \$400. The runner-ups receive a \$200 prize. For contest guidelines, prompts, and rubrics go to the National Rural Education Association website (www.nrea.net). Deadline for submission is April 1^{st} .

Annual Election of Executive Board Members: Missouri Association of Rural Education Executive Board Members shall serve two-year terms and are eligible for reelection. Elections or appointments shall be scheduled by the Executive Board with new Executive Board members taking office effective July 1, which is the beginning of the new fiscal year.
